Do you have a tough time separating "wants" from "needs"?


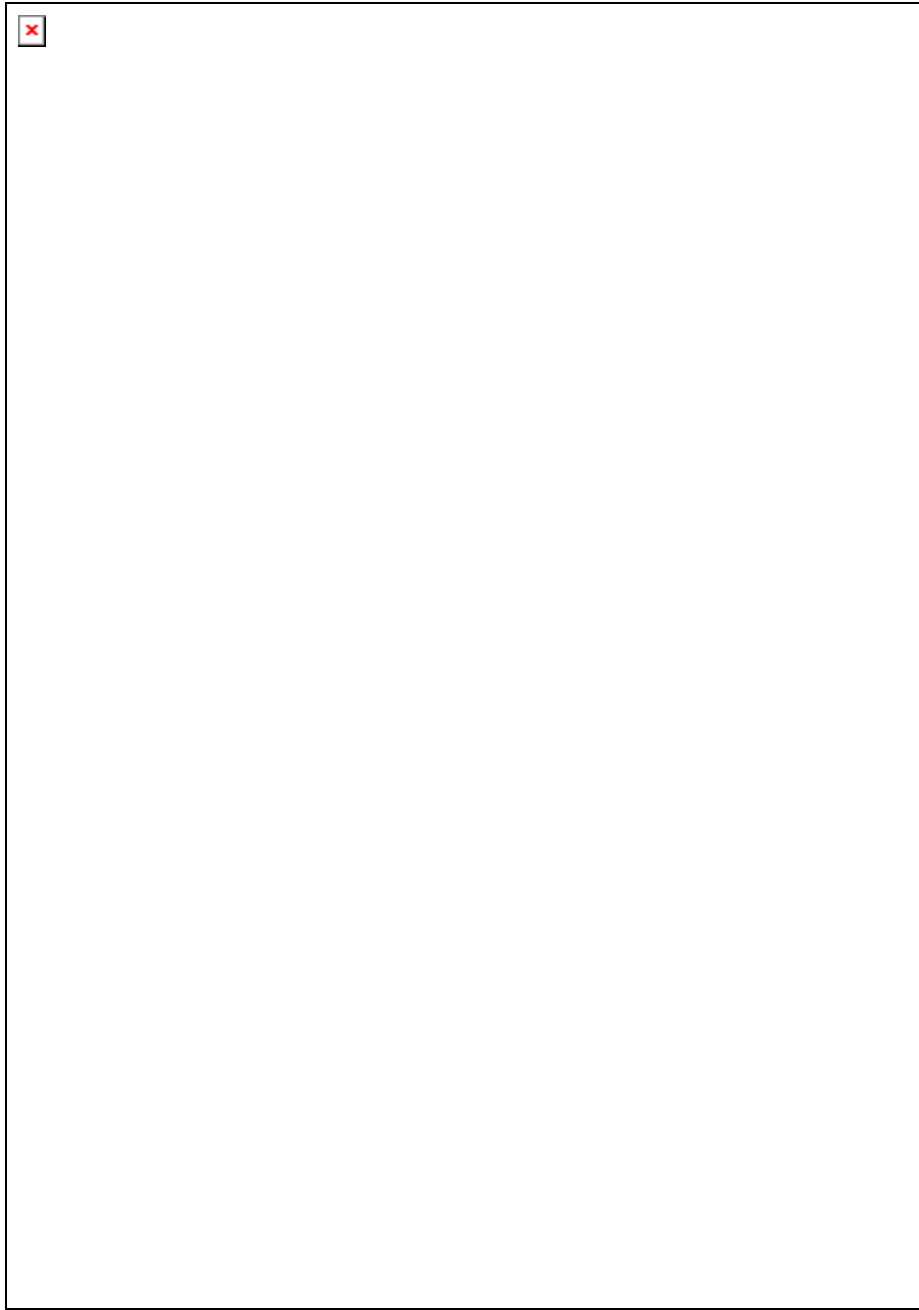
Do you sometimes feel consumed by the desire to have more?
